### 3. New Features

#### 3.1 Show Candidate Name in CV Download Notification

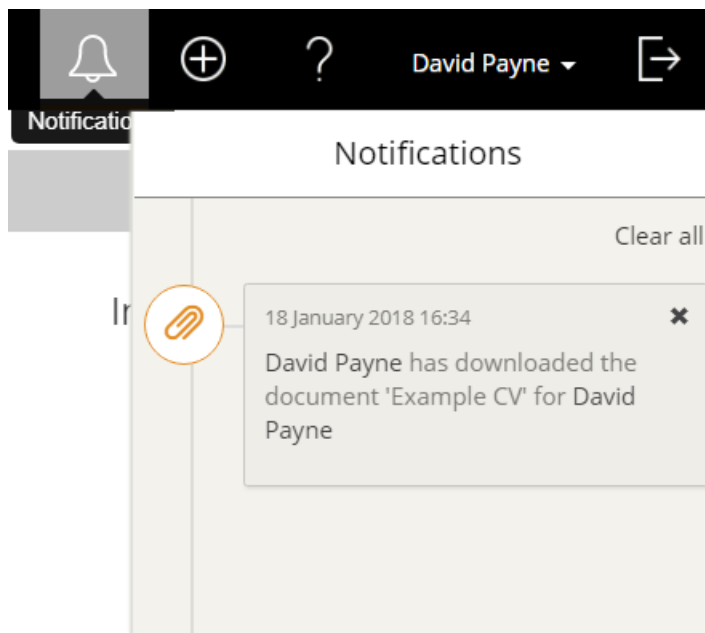

User Notes: The notification which is triggered when a document is downloaded via the sending of a CV, will now show the document description and the candidate name in the notification.



## 3.2 Option To Create Situation Record (When Parsing)

User Notes: When parsing a candidate record, we have added checkboxes within the Education and Work History tabs, which allow the user to select whether or not to create a candidate situation record.

There is also a Global Setting yes/no field under 'System' called 'Create Situation Record when Parsing?' this will default the boxes to be ticked or blank when using the parser.

## 3.3 Return To Search Results

User Notes: When a user clicks 'View Records' within search and then clicks on the 'Go Back to Search' button they are now automatically taken back to the search results pane. This includes returning the user to the results page they were viewing when they clicked 'View Records'.

## 3.4 Global Setting to turn on/off - Team Services Autobug logging

User Notes: There is a new Global Setting in the "System" section labelled "Log Autobugs?" When this setting is set to "Yes", whenever an unexpected error happens Colleague will be automatically notified of the error with a bug generated in the development backlog.

## 4. Bug Fixes

### 4.1 Alert on Documents Received Always Appearing?

Type: Bug

---

User Notes: When parsing from the Document's Received page, an alert would always appear saying that records matching the email address had been found. This has been corrected so that the alert only shows if matches have actually been found on the system.  
This alert will check all Candidate, Contact and Company records.

---

### 4.2 Lookups don't save if they are set to NULL/blank

---

Type: Bug

---

User Notes: An issue has been resolved where certain drop-down boxes were not saving when the selected value was blank. A separate issue has also been resolved regarding the creation of new offers from a requirement, when certain data is not present on the associated candidate record.

### 4.3 Interview time incorrect on interview records

User Notes: Fixed bug where the Interview record would not show the time of the Interview correctly.

### 4.4 Remove User Filter On Multiple Spec CV Sent Tab

User Notes: The Spec CV Sent tab on candidates, companies and contacts was only showing speculative CVs sent by the current consultant. This has now been updated to show all speculative CVs regardless of who sent them.
