Sprint Goal: Continue to enhance and refine the Search based on client feedback as well as working on workflow issues relating to the Requirement Candidate process.

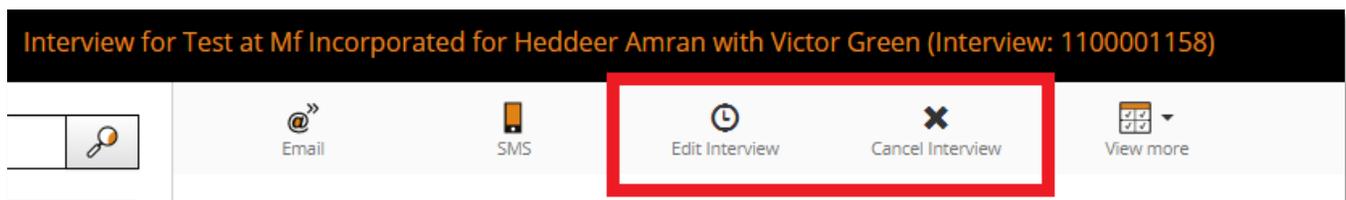
3. New Features

3.1 Need Option To Rearrange An Interview (Updating the Existing Interview)

State: Done

Type: Enhancement

User Notes: It is now possible for a user to edit and cancel interviews



On the interview record, you will find two new fields: Interview Type and Interview Status. On creating a new Interview, the Interview Status defaults to "Active". Clicking on the "Cancel Interview" button, will set the Interview Status to "Cancelled".

Before clicking on "Edit Interview", all fields on the Interview record are read only. Clicking on "Edit Interview" will make all of the fields editable (excluding Interview Status). However, any changes made to these fields are NOT automatically saved like with the rest of Colleague7. To save changes made, the user must click on the "Save" button. Changes can be cancelled by clicking on the "Cancel" button.

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3.3 PBI 32744 - Help with Clicking Back To Search From Candidate

User Notes: When opening a single result from a search, there is now an option to go back to the search from the record which was opened. This is in place for Candidate, Company, Contact and Requirement searches.

4. Bug Fixes

4.1 Working For Us Splash Screen Presented For Candidates Whose Placement Has Finished

State: Done

Type: Bug

User Notes: The 'Working for Us' alert, which appears when entering a candidate record which is in a placement, would on occasion appear when it was not supposed to.

We have modified this alert so that it will now take into account a permanent placement end date, also it will take into account whether the candidate record has been archived.

The full logic behind the splash alert is as follows:

- Does the candidate have an offer?
- Is the candidate in a contract role, where the start date is before today and the end date is after today?
- Is the candidate in a rolling contract, where the start date is before today and the end date is after today?
- Is the candidate in a rolling contract, where the start date is before today and there is no end date?
- Is the candidate in a perm placement where the start date is before today and there is no end date?
- If any of these conditions are true, then the Working for Us splash alert will show.

In addition to these modifications, a new global setting has been added to allow the exclusion of old permanent placements from the candidate 'Working for Us' checks.

Candidate The maximum age of permanent placements (in years) included in the 'Working for Us' check 2

This means that any permanent placements that started over the specified number of years will not be included when checking if a candidate is 'working for us'.

4.2 Lookup Values Not Appearing Correctly In Search / Search Results

Type: Bug

User Notes: Lookups and Users now appear correctly in data tables throughout Colleague 7. Also, some fields have been changed so that they appear correctly in Search, for example, Mailshot Status.

4.3 PBI 36227 - Interview Search Issues Raised by MG

User Notes: Fixed bug on the Requirement and Interview Selection screens where searching using date ranges did not work

4.4 PBI 36367 - Issue Viewing Documents In Document Preview
