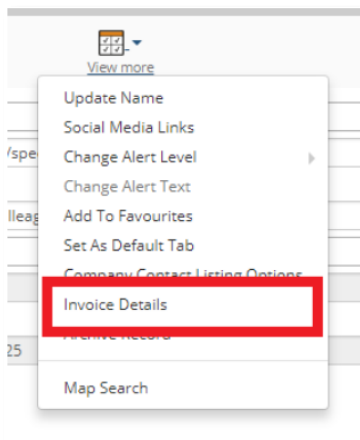
User Notes:

Invoice Details for Company records can now be stored in Colleague7 in preparation for our Back Office integration.

There is a new User Group Permission in called "Company - Invoice Details"





When this is set to "No Access", then users will not be able to view/edit Invoice Details on a Company.





When set to "Full Access", then the Invoice Details can be accessed on a Company record via the "View More" drop down menu

Clicking on "Invoice Details" will then reveal the Invoice Details section.

3.2 Text Kernel - Skills Management

When parsing, skills are now displayed within two categories, Colleague Skills and Text Kernel skills.

The skills listed within the Text Kernel skills are Text Kernel skills found within the CV.

Skills listed within the Colleague Skills area will also show the parent skill.
